

New AFM Racer Orientation

1. **Registration** (Opens at **6:30 am** & around **3:30-4:00 pm** Saturday)

- Where to register: **BW** – first floor main building / **IR** – first garage / **TH** – first floor main building
- Bring your hard card (license)
- Lap time sheets may be requested here

2. **Tech Inspection** (Open **7:00-8:30** coned tech area / **8:30-12:00 & 12:30-5:00** re-tech area / Once the track goes **cold** on Saturday, Tech will be open for **30-45 minutes** in the coned area)

- Look for the orange cones and blue AFM shirts
- Tech Inspection – Bring your **bike** with the belly pan removed, your **helmet** and your **pink tech slip**. (No need to bring the belly pan or your gear as long as you've had them inspected and have the proper stickers on your bike/helmet.)
- After being teched, roll your bike to a sticker person at the front of the tech line and give them the tech slip for a practice sticker. No sticker, no practice session.
- Re-tech – If you failed tech or crashed, you may fix the problem and re-tech. If the tech lines have been closed, come to the main tech area: **BW** – garage 5 / **IR** – garage 2 / **TH** – near hot pit entrance

3. **Mandatory Riders' Meeting**

- Saturday Riders' meeting usually starts at 8:00 am (**BW** – next to main building / **IR** – hot pit entrance / **TH** – start/finish) Be suited up if you're in practice group 1. Listen for calls over the PA and be on time! Refer to the race day program for the respective radio station PA feed.
- Items covered – track conditions, use of flags, starting procedures, event schedule, important news
- Any registered rider, if found not attending, may be fined
- The Riders' meeting on Sunday is **after** the last session of morning practice, just before the races begin. Be suited up and ready to race if you're in Race 1.

4. **Practice Sessions for Saturday and Sunday**

- There are typically 5 rotating practice sessions on Saturday 15-20 minutes long. Group 1 goes out first and Group 5 (fastest) goes last. Saturday groups rotate until about 3:30 pm with lunch at noon.
- Groups are determined by your last race times at that track. If you feel you are too fast for the group you are placed in, get a "Change Practice Sessions" form from registration and take the sheet to tech. If there is room for you in that group, Tech will have you bring your old practice sticker to swap it for the new one.
- There are typically 6 rotating sessions on Sunday 15-20 minutes long - one rotation before the races.

5. **Contingency Program**

- Contingency forms will be available near tech Saturday night and Sunday morning until 10:00 am

6. **Race Day**

- Grid sheets posted: **BW** - snack bar windows / **IR** - windows in garage #1 / **TH** - windows inside media center
- Clubman, Formula 40 and Vintage races run on Saturday afternoon
- Trophies can be picked up 30 minutes after the race results are official and posted
