

AFM - New Racers

This is introductory information for anyone who wants to go racing but isn't quite sure how to get started.

How do I get into Road Racing?

See rule book section 2.0 2.1, & 2.2 for licensing information.

First, you have to join the AFM. Get an application from us, fill it out completely and select which type of membership you want (Competition, Reciprocity, Associate), and mail it back to the AFM with the appropriate fees. You can get an application by clicking on the License Application page, or call us (510) 796-7005, leave your mailing and phone number information.

License Application should be submitted prior to entry. Allow a minimum of 48 hours following receipt of application for processing. After processing is complete we will e-mail you with instructions on how to proceed with your entry.

Within 10 days you will receive a rulebook, race schedule card, AFM sticker, subscription offer from Roadracing World, and your AFM license card. If you have not completed a NRS you will not receive a AFM license card until you have do so. Once an AFM member you will receive all e-blasts and mailings throughout the year. All Competition or Reciprocity members will have their own myAFM account that will contain your bike, practice times, race finishes, entry and payment histories.
